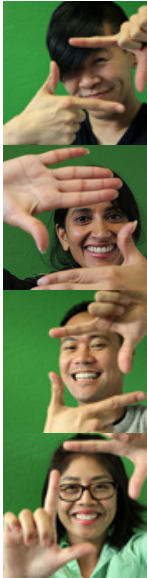

I, the undersigned _____ (please print your name) ("Applicant"), grant the Banyan Tree Project and Asian & Pacific Islander Wellness Center permission to use all and/or part of my digital storytelling project for promotional and educational uses as shall be set forth in further detail below. Applicant grants to the Banyan Tree Project and Asian & Pacific Islander Wellness Center the rights to the Applicant's digital storytelling project, in whole or in part, and at any state of completion ("Project Materials") for any Asian & Pacific Islander Wellness Center purpose, including but not limited to: educational, advertising, press, marketing and/or promotional activities in any medium ("Granted rights").
